1.00 C. The Contractor shall submit a hard copy of the Tender Document within 72 hours from the bid lock. This copy will be opened only in case of deficiencies in the e-Tender procedure.

1.1 EARNEST MONEY (EMD):

- i) Earnest Money shall be paid online using the payment gateway <https://pay.madhavnetralaya.org/?t=emd> or via Demand Draft in Favor of *Madhav Netralaya Eye Institute and Research Centre payable at Nagpur*. Tenderers who do not deposit the Earnest Money in one of the above acceptable forms shall be summarily rejected.
- ii) The amount will be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderer after the decision regarding acceptance or otherwise, and after expiry of the tender validity period. In the case of the successful tenderer, it will be appropriated initially as the Security Deposit.

1.2 SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD):

The successful tenderer whose tender is accepted will have to pay the balance amount towards the Security Deposit as mentioned in the “Details of Work”.

1.3 ADDITIONAL PERFORMANCE SECURITY:

After opening Envelope No. 1 and 2, the L1 bidder shall submit the Additional Performance Security Deposit within a period of 8 days. This 8-day period will not be relaxed under any circumstances. If the L1 bidder fails to submit the Additional Performance Security Deposit within the stipulated period, the bid of the second lowest bidder (L2) shall be considered.

Guidelines for Payment of Additional Performance Security (APS)

Applicable when the offer is lower than the estimated amount put to tender

1. The Contractor shall submit the Original Bank Guarantee (BG) or Original Demand Draft (DD) amounting to 1%.
2. The Bank Guarantee/Demand Draft shall be drawn from any Nationalized/Scheduled Bank in Favor of *Madhav Netralaya Eye Institute and Research Centre payable at Nagpur*.
3. If the Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft is found to be false or invalid, the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of the tenderer shall be forfeited. The MICR and IFSC code of the issuing bank must be printed on the Demand Draft.
4. The Additional Performance Security submitted by the L1 contractor will be refunded after Successful Completion of Work.

1.4 IMPORTANT

1.5 Rates and Taxes

The rates quoted by the Contractor shall be deemed inclusive of labour welfare cess and all other taxes (except GST) payable for the execution of the contract. The Employer shall deduct applicable taxes at source as per prevailing laws.

Payment of GST

- i) The Bidder shall quote rates excluding GST.
- ii) GST shall be payable on the accepted contract value.
- iii) GST shall be paid to the Contractor on the value of work done, as per the prevailing GST rate during the execution period.

iv) Royalty of excavated material will be paid separately upon submission of the Royalty Challans of the concerned department.

1.6 Royalty Charges for Material

1. As the quoted rates are exclusive of royalty charges, the Contractor must procure all required minor minerals by paying the applicable royalty.
2. The Contractor shall submit royalty-paid passes for the minor minerals consumed for the quantities mentioned in each respective bill.
3. In the absence of royalty pass details, the equivalent amount shall be withheld from R.A. Bills.

2.1.21 OPENING OF TENDERS:

On the date, specified in the Tender Notice.
Following procedure will be adopted for opening of the Tender.

(A) ENVELOPE No. 1 (Technical Envelope)

First of all, Envelope No. 1 of the tender will be opened online to verify its contents as per requirements. If the various documents contained in this envelope do not meet the requirements, a note will be recorded accordingly by the tender opening authority and the said tenderer's Envelope No. 2 will not be considered for further action and the same will be rejected. Any clarification required for any documents will be sought but at the sole discretion of the Tender opening authority.

The decision of the tender opening authority in this regard will be final and binding on the contractors.

(B) ENVELOPE No. 2: (Financial Envelope)

This envelope shall be opened online immediately after opening of Envelope No. 1, only if contents of Envelope No. 1 are found to be acceptable. The tendered rates in Schedule 'B' or percentage above/below the estimated rates shall then be read out in presence of contractors who remain present at the time of opening of Envelope No.2.

2.1.22 TIME LIMIT:

The work is to be completed within as specified 6 months.

1.1.23 ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER:

Acceptance of tender shall rest with the Project Coordinator, Madhav Netralaya, Vasudeo Nagar, Nagpur, who reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof. The tenderer whose tender is accepted will have to enter in to a regular B-1 Agreement within 8 days of being notified to do so. In case of failure on the part of Tenderer to sign the Agreement within the stipulated time, the earnest money paid by him shall stand forfeited and the offer of the tenderer shall be considered as withdrawn by him.

2.1.24 CONDITIONAL TENDER:

The tenders who do not fulfill the condition of the notification and the general rules

and directions for the guidance of Contractor in the Agreement form or are incomplete in any respect are likely to be rejected without assigning any reason therefore.

- a. The Tenderer shall be presumed to have carefully examined the drawings, conditions and specifications of the work and have fully acquainted themselves with all details of the site, the conditions of rock and its joints, pattern, river, weather characteristics, labour conditions.
- b. The data whatsoever supplied by the Project Coordinator along with the tender documents are meant to serve only as guide for the tenderers while tendering and the Project Coordinator accepts no responsibility whatsoever either for the accuracy of data or for their comprehensiveness.

Responsibility for the veracity of document submitted by the contractor: -

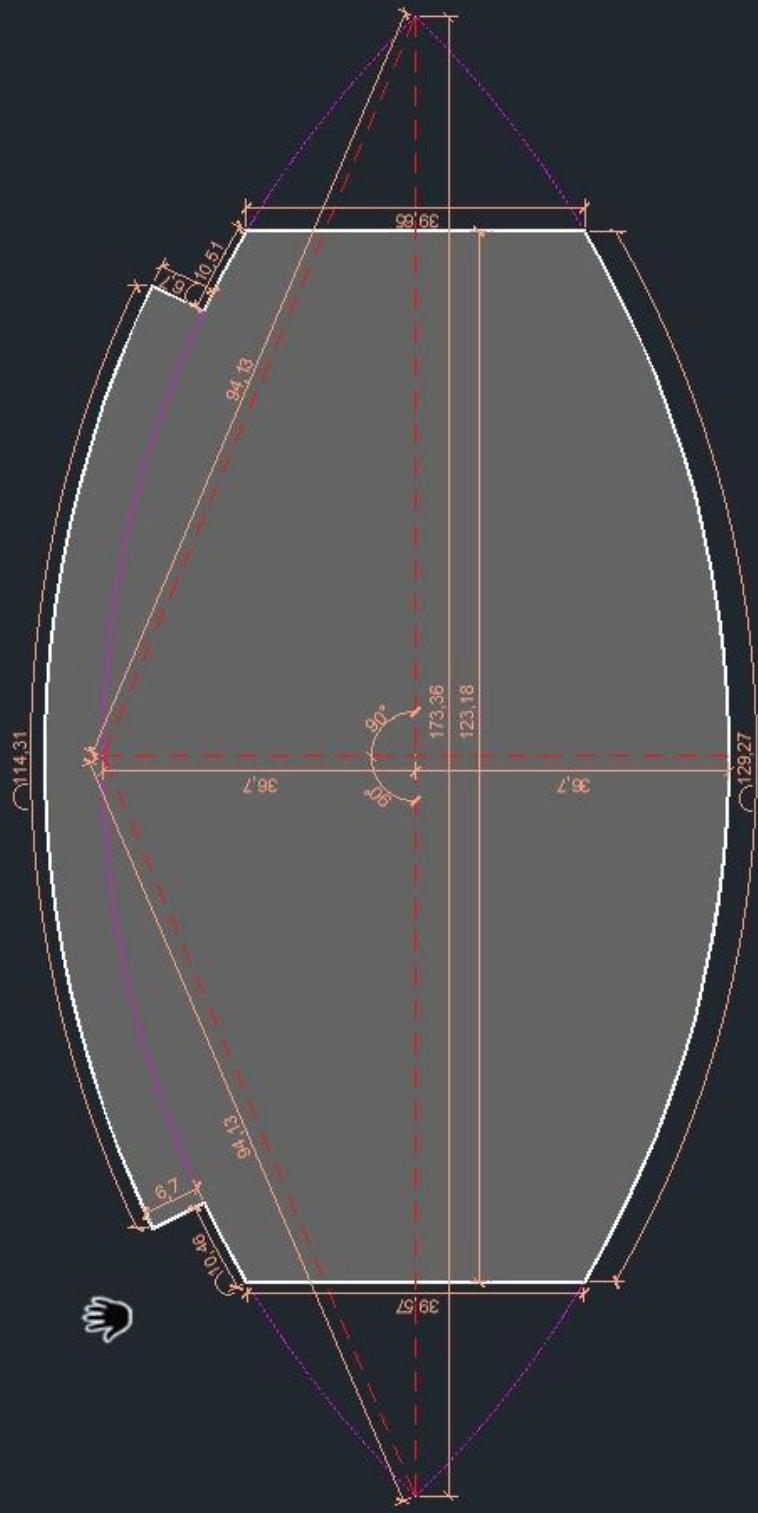
